10 Highlights of NLF 10 years

- The sponsorship base has grown from 1 American family, David and Jai Wicklund from Wisconsin to more than 100 sponsors from USA, New Zealand, South Korea and Norway.
- The school membership has increased from 14 students and 6 members of staff to 405 students and 52 members of staff.
- The Fountain of Love department has been able to minister to many students deliverance from evil forces like witchcraft and demon possession. Many have found and embraced salvation after joining NLF.
- The students have grown into ministers of the gospel in street, prison, hospital and church ministry. Many of them are able to distinctively hear from God.
- NLF students have always turned out to be either the best or among the best students whenever they join other schools.
- The Fountain of Hope Primary school is now the envy of many neighboring schools, turning out highly successful students every time exams are done. The current Grade 7 students all passed the most recent district exams - holding the first position in the whole district.
- NLF will churn out its first Grade 12 graduates this year. They are a 43 strong group of youngsters who are talented in so many things. Amongst them are faithful people of God, great worship leaders, actors, charismatic leaders, sportsmen, musicians, prophets of God to mention but a few.
- Since the inception of NLF, many children have been saved from the 'dungeon' in their infancy. This has happened through the Fountain of Zoe which rescues infants who are abandoned either due to disease, death of parents or many other sad causes.
- The Fountain of Joy has over the years been able to rescue many a teenage girl who has been rejected by family due to getting pregnant out of wedlock. The girls have been given training in handiworks that could help them eke out their own living and support their families. This year there are 15 students. 4 of them are from the remote Sonjo area and the rest are from Moshi in Tanzania.
- NLF initially started with zero acres of land and currently has 40 acres of land - thanks to all our faithful supporters from all over.

There are 11 students who begun nursery school in NLF and are now in the secondary school.

It was a time of testimony after testimony as various departments gave glory to God for the many deeds He has done among them during the 10 years. The students read reports testifying how they had come to know the Lord as their personal savior after joining NLF. They also had beautiful performances one of them being a prophetic dance which they organized on their own.

God graciously helped NLF to host international teams from India(Paul and Caroline), USA(Nick Stuva), and New Zealand (Geoff Matthews and a team of about 30, comprising staff and students of Hebron College).

He taught about the principles of a good Christian school. The New Zealand team were such a blessing. They actively ministered in the school by attending and leading the worship services and also organized so many games with all the children. At the conference, they performed English, Kiswahili and New Zealand songs. Emily, one of the best singers in New Zealand sang a dedication to NLF. Many were moved to tears by the song which encouraged all to move on despite the odds.

The New Zealand team performed their famous war dance "Haka" which depicts spiritual warfare. Ola Muan the NLF representative from Norway sent his greetings in a moving report sent to the conference. Chuck Carlson a representative from USA sent his greetings that were read by Dave Schlachter, who was an instrument as a lawyer who helped incorporate NLF in USA

NLF had a great favor from God to be one of the organizers along with CIC, World Vision, Compassion International, CEF and AWANA International. This summit ministers to children aged 4 to 14. Many have forgotten this very important age group for imparting God's truth .The Bible says "Train a child in the way He should go and when he grows up he will not depart from it." God is raising many organizations to work for this group of children. Our student shared to the summit about her early life when she lived with her alcoholic father and abusive mother, and how they later died leaving her orphaned. She gave thanks to God for bringing her to NLF, rescuing her and giving her an education.

Fountain of Joy

Fountain of Joy enrolled 14 new students in July. Four of these ladies are from the remote Sonjo area in Tanzania which has no social amenities while the rest are from near Moshi. The girls were taken through intensive spiritual training to give them an opportunity to keep their hearts right with God. Most of the Fountain of Joy students are school drop-outs or girls who have been rejected by family due to teenage pregnancies. These girls are offered a wholesome education with life skills to enable them to make a living for themselves and their families once they complete their courses.
