
July Visits

A group of three New Life Foundation supporters from New Zealand gave us a very special visit this month. Philanthropist Gina Satterthwaite, acclaimed fashion designer Denise L'Estrange-Corbet and businessman Jeremy North were greeted by a press conference upon arrival into the country then welcomed by traditional dance to New Life Foundation's headquarters in Mailisita.

Gina purchased 30 acres of land (currently worth well over \$500,000) for New Life Foundation to build Kilimanjaro Fountain of Hope University around the Maili Sita area after watching a video by NZ celebrity designer Denise who had visited NLF in 2005. This was Gina's first visit to New Life Foundation and to the land – which will be renamed in her honor. Our children and our administration want to again thank Gina, Denise and Jeremy for their blessed visit, continual support and loving generosity. *Asanteni sana!*

Hebron Christian College's Mission to Tanzania 2013 was a resounding success on all accounts. Our New Zealand partners, headed by Hebron principal and NLF NZ board chairman, Mr. Geoff Matthews, sent their fifth missions team to love and serve our children here at New Life – and even beyond. The 23-person had an action-packed week that saw them go on a mission to Tanga where they were a part of a huge outdoor evangelistic festival. **17,000 people** from the predominantly-Muslim city of Tanga gave their lives to Christ over the course of the festival.

Back in Kilimanjaro, the team blessed all of New Life's four divisions – Fountain of Hope, Fountain of Zoë, Fountain of Joy and Fountain of Love – with song, dance, donations and even bits of New Zealand culture like the Maori *kapahaka*. How huge a blessing Hebron have been since the seeds of this relationship were sown by a simple email exchange back in 2004 cannot be overstated! Through this, our teachers have visited NZ to learn from Hebron, five teams of Hebron students have visited NLF and hundreds of thousands of dollars have been raised for the work the Lord does through us here at NLF Tanzania! 😊

It included speeches and reports from NLF President, Glorious Shoo, NLF New Zealand Chair, Mr. Geoff Matthews, along with administration representatives from our friends at World Vision and Compassion International. The speeches were tied into this year's theme: *Raising a generation that obeys God's guidance*. We had representation and/or a message from New Life Foundation's six international offices: Tanzania, New Zealand (23 members from Hebron Christian College), Norway, South Korea, Canada and the USA.
