Hello friend,

Easter greetings to you. Our Lord Jesus Christ truly deserves all our praise! We have had another amazing month here at New Life – as you will read, and we are ever grateful to him. When I think of the sacrifice and the love of Jesus to us, I am reminded of how he continues to show us this love through his people, who are sharing this same love and sacrificing for the children we serve.

We want to thank you for your love and support. Organizations like ours depend on the hearts of giving from people like you to be able to do the work we do, and touch the lives we touch. Your support keeps our work alive!

One of the best ways to support our ministry directly is to sponsor one of our children. Our sponsorship program covers children in Fountain of Hope – our schools for the needy – and Fountain of Zoë – our home for abandoned babies. In our school of over 600, we currently have around 100 unsponsored children who depend on New Life Foundation completely. Due to the success of our church's ministry to Moshi's red light district (as reported in previous newsletters), we will also be adding 20 new children from the ladies who were saved through this amazing ministry.



Amazing National Exam Results!



The national examination results for our last Form Four (Class of 2013) are in, and they are something to praise God about. Tanzanian students do a standardized, nation-wide exam at the end of their O-level high school (American 12th grade equivalent) to allow them to go on to higher education. All of our children have passed this year's national exams, and the school is ranked as one of the best among private schools. Fountain of Hope placed 3rd in the Kilimanjaro region and 43rd in the whole country of Tanzania (out of 1,099 schools in the private schools category). We are really grateful to God and to our teachers for the hard work they put in over the past year. It is immensely fulfilling to have children come to us as needy babies and leave with a quality Christian education. ☺


Planting Season

The rainy season has just begun here in Northern Tanzania and that usually means it's time to plant on our school's farms. This year, we allocated a little over 30 acres of our land for farming purposes, and our senior kids were hard at work planting maize, beans and sunflowers. We are hoping to harvest enough maize and beans to feed the whole school for several months, and have some to take to market. The sunflower seeds will be used to make cooking oil. ☺
