Signs & Wonders Festival!

New Life Foundation participated in the Mission SOS Signs & Wonders Festival in Moshi in partnership with Sweden-based international evangelistic ministry, SOS Missions. The revivalist event gathered over 5,000 people in Moshi's Mashujaa grounds for five electric nights of the gospel, the Holy Spirit and miracles! The blind saw, the deaf could hear, the lame walked and souls were brought into the family of God under the lordship of Jesus Christ. Fountain of Hope children played many roles at the gospel crusade, serving as ushers, translators, intercessors and ministering to both children and adults with skits, songs, and puppets. New Life Foundation President, Bishop Glorious F. Shoo, who is also Mission SOS' Regional Director for East Africa, hosted powerful man of God and SOS ministry's leader, Evangelist Johannes Amritzer, in his home town of Moshi for the first time. In Tanzania alone, Mission SOS had already done Signs & Wonders Festivals in the cities of Dar es Salaam, Tanga, Mwanza and Samé - bringing hundreds of thousands of Tanzanians to Christ in fulfillment of the Great Commission. We are blessed to be partners with Evangelist Amritzer and Mission SOS in the spreading of the gospel and the fulfillment of scripture in these last days!



Leadership Training in Tanzania

New Life Foundation partnered with the US-based conservative leadership organization, the Leadership Institute, to hold a leadership training event at Moshi's Peace Park. Over four hundred Tanzanian leaders and aspiring leaders in business, education, and society at large gathered for practical leadership training under the Leadership Institute's Dr. Miguel Moreno, New Life Foundation's Bishop Glorious F. Shoo, and Mission SOS' Ev. Johannes Amritzer. The three-day event was split into three distinct schools: The International Fundraising School, The International Communications School, and The School of Leadership and the Conservative Organizational Entrepreneur, each ending with Evangelist Amritzer's powerful message of Africa's coming emergence into leading the world across all spheres of influence. The Leadership Institute is a leadership organization that has trained leaders in over 82 countries worldwide, notable ones including former US VP, Dick Cheney, and Tanzanian parliamentarians Honorable Amos Makalla and Honorable Emmanuel Nchimbi. We are honored to be able to work with such esteemed partners and look forward to the fruits of this blossoming relationship.

New Life Foundation was invited to the 4/14 Window Movement Summit in Bangkok, Thailand through our friends at Compassion International. Our Communications Officer, Princely H. Glorious, represented the organization at the international children's ministry summit this year. The 4/14 Window Movement is a child evangelism movement focused on developing missions strategies on reaching children between the ages of 4 and 14 with the gospel. The inspiration for the 4 to 14 Window is based on the finding that "71% of Christians give their life to Christ before the age of 15," and the movement aims to highlight the importance of ministering to children and working with children in ministry. The Summit in Bangkok brought together thousands of children's ministers and ministries from over 80 countries worldwide for a time of refreshing, equipping and networking!


Quick Report

Fountain of Hope has never ranked outside of the top 150 schools in Tanzania in its 6 years of taking the exams. We're looking forward to the results for our class of 2013!
